



### Active Directory Object Manager

- **Enforce** password policy changes on VPN users
- **Manage** Group Policy Object updates on VPN connected machines
- **Consolidate** and manage Group Policy Objects based upon chassis type
- **Organize** computer objects in Microsoft® Active Directory relative to user objects and chassis type
- **Maintain** domain membership of trusted computer objects
- **Improve** the Return on Investment, on desktop management software that tie into Active Directory
- **Assure** security compliance by deactivating dormant and inactive user IDs in Active Directory



# Automated Active Directory objects management

## Organize → Manage → Relax !

- **Enforce password policy changes on VPN users**
  - Prompt VPN users to change password upon password expiration*
  - Synchronize VPN users cached credentials with domain credentials*
- **Manage GPO updates on VPN connected PCs**
  - Apply Group Policies as soon as VPN connection to corporate network is established*
- **Organize computer objects in Microsoft® Active Directory**
  - Maintain domain membership, even over VPN connections. ADOM is sysprep on steroids !*
  - Tag computer objects by updating description field (customizable), managedBy, location and other attributes*
- **Consolidate and manage GPO**
  - Manage GPO based upon chassis type and using security filtering*
  - Maintain single policy for 'Desktops' and single policy for 'laptops'*
  - Maintain single group policy link at domain level instead of at multiple organizational unit levels*
- **Assure security compliance**
  - Auto expire dormant and inactive accounts*
  - No need to consolidate VPN connector logs and AD security logs, VPN user (even cached credentials) is logged in domain controller security log*
- **Improve Return on Investment**
